RULES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR MISS PREAKNESS 2009 CONTEST

The young woman selected will be expected to appear at a series of Preakness promotional events and the race itself to do public relations work. These events are attended and viewed by more than 80 million people on television. If you are selected to be a part of this very special celebration, you will be expected to be at all events at least 15 minutes ahead of the scheduled time and remain until released by Preakness Officials.

These events will occur between May 9th and May 16th 2009. You will also be expected to perform all tasks required by these officials. The scholarship will be awarded after the completion of all events; the check will be mailed and made payable to the designated college or university in the name of Miss Preakness for any semester.

Miss Preakness will be selected in the following manner assuming she meets the basic requirements stated in the letter above:

- All contestants must submit an application and photograph (photo must be black and white glossy, no crown, flowers, trophies, etc.).
- Committee of Pimlico employees will review the pictures and applications and select the top five contestants.
- These five finalists will be called in for a 7-minute private interview with a separate panel of judges. These interviews will be held during the first week of May.
- The top five finalists will be required to sign a Contestant's Release and Indemnity Agreement before they are interviewed.
- A three judge panel will select Miss Preakness 2009.
- The winner will be told after the interviews or by telephone.
